(Provide exact wording, use separate sheet/s if necessary)	<p>That the second Paragraph of Archery Australia Rule 8.1 be amended as follows.</p> <p>Note For outdoor target, Indoor and Clout Archery the specifications for Longbow equipment as detailed in FITA Article 9.3 shall apply, with the exception of Clause 9.3.7.2 In this respect wooden and/or aluminium arrow must be used .</p> <p>For Field Archery FITA article 9.3 shall apply and wooden arrows must be used.</p> <p>Arrows may be shot using either the Mediterranean release That is, one (1) finger above and (2) two fingers below the arrow, where the fingers above and immediately below must touch the arrow, or using a thumb ring as per FITA Clause 9.3.8.5.</p> <p>The proposed rule change will allow the use of Aluminium or wooden arrows for Target, Indoor and Clout but not for Field where wooden arrows must be used.</p>
